PRESS RELEASE

01/28/2010 - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies investigated a one car rollover MVA on State Route 96, in the Town of Romulus, New York. Deputies' report that a vehicle operated by Michael A. Vosburg, age 43, 338 Dryden Har Road, Dryden, New York was north bound on State Route 96 near the intersection with State Route 414, an area commonly referred to as bulls' head, when he lost control due to speed and slippery road conditions. Vosburg's vehicle left the roadway and overturned at least one time before it came to rest in a field on the north east side of the road. Vosburg, who was the lone occupant of the vehicle suffered a minor head injury and was taken by South Seneca Ambulance to Geneva General Hospital where he was treated and released. Ovid Fire and Rescue assisted at the scene. Vosburg's vehicle was heavily damaged and towed from the scene. No summonses were issued
