## **PRESS RELEASE**

07/28/2010 @ 1022 HRS - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a two car personal injury accident at the intersection of Route 5&20 and Route 414, in the Town of Seneca Falls. The driver of the first vehicle Louis A Ferrara, age 60, of 17 Swaby Street, Seneca Falls, N.Y., was traveling westbound on Route 5&20 when he was struck by a vehicle making a left turn from Route 5&20 onto Route 414 northbound. The second vehicle was being operated by Stephanie M. Brocious, age 28, of 190 Fall Street, Seneca Falls, N.Y. The investigation revealed that Brocious disobeyed a traffic light and turned into the path of the Ferrara vehicle that had the right of way. Both vehicles had to be towed from the scene. Ferrara was transported by North Seneca Ambulance to Geneva General Hospital for a complaint of chest pain. Brocious was ticketed for failure to obey a traffic control device. The Waterloo Fire Dept. assisted at the scene.

07/25/2010 @ 0556 HRS - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a personal injury motor vehicle accident on State Route 414 in the Town of Lodi, New York. Deputies report that Christopher L Caslin, age 37, of 5449 Wilkinson Road, Hector, N.Y., was traveling south on State Route 414 when he left the west shoulder of the roadway, hitting an embankment, causing the vehicle to roll several times and strike a tree. Deputies report that the Lodi Fire Department and South Seneca Ambulance responded and Mercy Flight flew Caslin to Strong Memorial Hospital for treatments.
